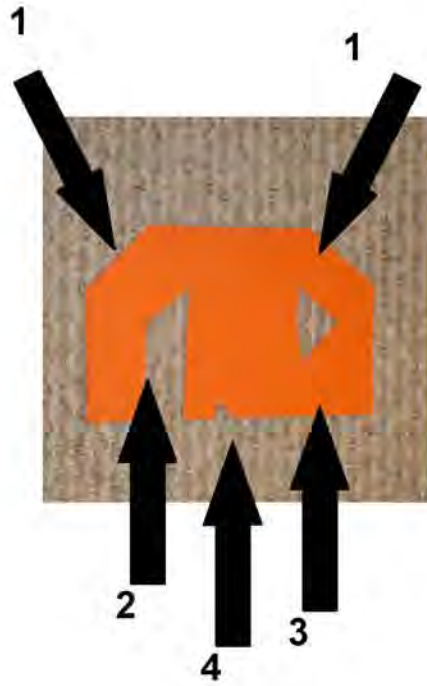


The Little Orange House

Directions



1. Fold 9x12" sheet of orange construction paper in half. Hold the fold at the bottom with open sides up. The first cut is for the roof. Cut both of the top corners off. This will make all four corners cut.

2. As you tell the story, the second cut is the mouth. Make a rectangular shape, but cut up to make a point to the right --as shown in the picture

3. The next cut is for the windows. These are the trickiest of all. You will need to fold again and cut a triangle shape through both layers. Note the spacing on the orange paper. Also, make the triangle half as big as you want the finished eyes to be on the pumpkin.

4. Last cut is for the nose. Make a small triangle shape above the mouth as shown in photo.

After all the cuts are made, you can open the paper to see the jack-o-lantern house. I have found it very helpful to practice making the cuts prior to telling the story!
